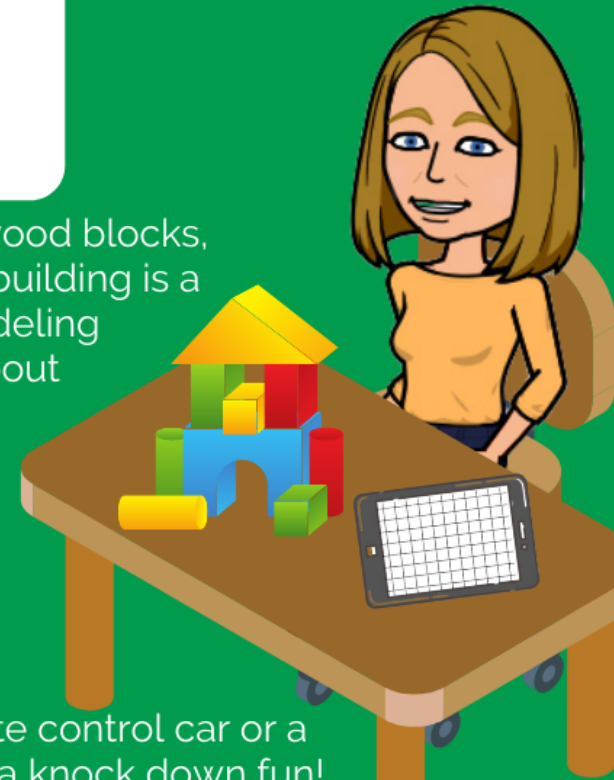
Talk About Building
